

This character is pronounced 'ni' (*nee*).

Trace over the grey characters to get used to the shape



There are 2 parts to this character:

亻 The diagonal should be written first from top to side, followed by the vertical line

尔 Again, the diagonal should be written first, then the horizontal line with downward hook. The next line is the vertical line with upward hook, followed by the dash to the left and finally the dash to the right

This character is pronounced 'hao' (*how*)

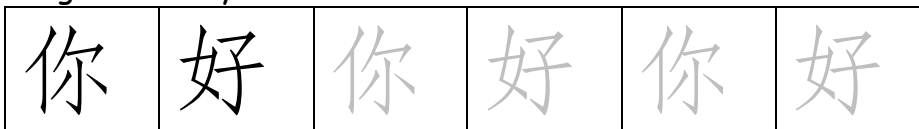


There are also 2 parts to this character:

女 Begin at the top with 2 sides of an irregular triangle (this is one stroke even though there is a change of direction half way down). Next is the bottom diagonal that crosses through the lower line you have just written, finishing with the horizontal line.

子 Start with the top horizontal with downward hook, then the vertical hook which flicks upwards at the bottom. Finish with the straight horizontal line (left to right)

Together they make 'ni hao' which means hello
